*Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
 Bishop Stephen Robson and I are writing to you today to share our joy and excitement with you that Pope Francis has named a new Archbishop of St Andrews and Edinburgh.*

*The Archbishop-Elect is Monsignor Leo Cushley, a priest of the Diocese of Motherwell, who has been in the Diplomatic Service of the Holy See for many years. In that capacity, more recently he has been serving in the Holy See's Secretariat of State at the Vatican in a senior position which brought him into almost daily contact with Pope Benedict XVI and with Pope Francis.*

*As he said in his interviews on the day when his nomination was announced, Monsignor Leo Cushley is keenly aware of the delicate moment in which he will take up the government of this Archdiocese. Our new Archbishop-Elect went on to say that he sincerely hopes to be "a humble, simple and wise shepherd" who will serve the flock entrusted to him "in truth and in charity, with a view to reconciliation and healing among the Catholics of Edinburgh."*

*Our new Archbishop will be consecrated in St Mary's Cathedral, Edinburgh, on the Feast of St Matthew, the Apostle and Evangelist, Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2013. As we wait to welcome him as Archbishop, we thank God for his appointment and we pray earnestly for him to our Lord Jesus Christ, invoking also the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church. We declare a special period of prayer for the new Archbishop, to run from 6<sup>th</sup> August, the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, to the day of his episcopal consecration.*
