The Annual National Pilgrimage to Carfin will be held on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> September. Concelebrated Mass will start at 3.00 p.m.

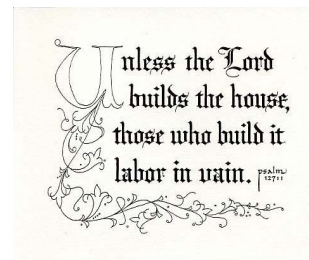

#### Prayers please

We need to pray, and to pray constantly if we want something seriously. Do we really want a better Church? Do we want a better world? Do we want a stronger faith? Do we want better families? #### Visits by chaplains in our hospitals

I visit the hospital regularly, especially when I know that parishioners are admitted, and as often as I am called out in emergencies. But there are many catholic patients who do not come to my notice or to the notice of other Chaplains and Eucharistic Ministers. Even when patients are asked their religion when they are admitted, we do not get informed due to Data Protection legislation. You may have wondered why some Catholic patients get a visit and you did not. Patients or their relatives must make it clear that they would like a visit from the Priest. And even when this request has been made the information does not always get passed on.

#### To make sure that you do get a visit from the chaplain:

1. Inform your own Parish Priest and ask him to let the Priest on call know, if he cannot visit himself.
2. Inform the Spiritual Care Team. The office is on ground floor, next to the Prayer Room (South corridor) - tel. 0131 242 1900. They will phone us and let us know if it is an emergency or if it can wait. It is very annoying for us to be visiting patients and go past others who may be in the next ward or at times even in the same room.

The same applies if you wish Communion from a visiting Eucharistic Minister. Let the Spiritual Care Team know. Eucharistic Ministers visit mostly on Sundays.
