Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church

27. Man is created by God and therefore has the desire for God implanted in him, together with a yearning for goodness and truth. God draws man to himself and man in turn searches to satisfy his longing.

28 This search for God has found different expressions in prayer, sacrifice, worship and meditation, which however confused, can be found throughout history in every culture, and convince us that man is a religious being.

31. Man comes to a knowledge of the existence of God through convincing and convergent arguments ('Proofs for the Existence of God') which allow him to reach certainty. These can be divided into proofs from Creation and proofs from human nature itself.
