# LENTEN INITIATIVES

**A Ways of Praying Course** – different parishioners offering their wisdom and experience in their preferred way of praying – on Mondays at 2.30pm and Wednesdays at 7pm – Presentation/Witness/Experience.

- ❖ **Week 1** – 2.30pm, Monday 11 March and 7pm Wednesday 13 March - **Devotional Prayer** (the Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Divine Mercy) – in St John’s Hall
- ❖ **Week 2** - Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Intercessory Prayer – in St Mary Magdalene’s Hall
- ❖ **Week 3** - Lectio Divina/Praying with Scripture – at St John’s
- ❖ **Week 4** - The Breviary/the Prayer of the Church, and Praying Online – at St Mary Magdalene’s

## ALSO....

- ❖ Each weekday (from Monday to Friday) there is the **Morning Prayer of the Church** at 9.30am in the St John's Hall/Parish House
- ❖ On Wednesday mornings, there is **Stations of the Cross** in the Prayer Room in the Parish House after the 10am Eucharistic Service.

.....and there is also the opportunity to participate in what we offer each week throughout the year:

- ❖ each day there is **Mass** in either St Mary Magdalene's or St John's (in church or hall), normally at 10am.
- ❖ each week there is **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**: normally on Wednesdays from 9.25am to 9.55am at St Mary Magdalene's, and on Saturdays from 9am to 9.55am at St John's.
- ❖ On Fridays there are **Divine Mercy Devotions** from 3-4pm in the Prayer Room in the Parish House.
